Abstract: Conceptualizing particular phrases specific to new disciplines and occupations emerged during post-industrial society (also a new phrase, introduced by the American sociologist Daniel Bell in 1980, which intended to synthesize in a word the "service-based economy"), still raises numerous and complex problems of semantic nature for specialists in the respective fields. Some concepts related to certain disciplines of social science or certain ergonomic concepts have been taken over tale-quale by the practitioners in the field, from the dominant languages (generally from English and French) without taking into account the fact that Romanian had already conceptualized and defined those terms. The consequence of such a situation was the confusion in understanding certain terms and their use with different meanings, most often inappropriate. The article aims to disambiguate the content of the term "supervision" in social assistance management.
