Abstract: The European Parliament Resolution from 29 September 2010 supports Gross Domestic Product as the “key yardstick” for determining eligibility for regional assistance while other indicators may be added with room left for national authorities to decide on additional criteria depending on local reality. In this respect, we believe that an indicator tailored to the specificities of Romania’ regions is desirable to eliminate the development gaps among regions. Our proposal for financial allocation based on a multicriterial indicator is the purpose of this article and one of the possible points of analysis for future policy decisions.
